3. Dealership Checklist: What to Inspect

Exterior Inspection:

1. VIN & Paperwork: Verify that the VIN matches your paperwork.
2. Body and Paint: Check for any paint defects, chips, or scratches. Inspect all body panels for panel gap misalignment.
3. Underside: Look for scrapes, damage, or any loose bolts under the vehicle.
4. Tires & Wheels: Confirm tire pressures are even and within normal ranges. Inspect wheels for curb rash.

Functional Tests:

1. Doors and Windows: Test all doors and windows for smooth operation. Inspect weather stripping.
2. Frunk, Gear Tunnel, and Tailgate: Test automatic/manual operations of the frunk and gear tunnel doors.

3. Exterior Lights: Inspect headlights, turn signals, brake lights, and puddle lights.
4. Charge Port: Test the charge port door and ensure the charge indicator light works.
5. Cameras: Test all camera views (front, rear, and side).
6. Rear Seat Touchscreen: Ensure the rear seat touchscreen is fully functional. Test the climate control, media, and any other available features controlled by the rear screen.

4. At Home Checklist: What to Inspect Post-Delivery

Charging System:

1. Home Charger Setup: Test charging with your home charger or a public charger.
2. DC Fast Charging Test: If possible, test DC fast charging at a fast charger.

Software & Updates:

1. Firmware Check: Ensure that the vehicle's software is up-to-date via the Rivian app.
2. Infotainment System: Test maps, GPS, music streaming, and Bluetooth functionality.

Water Intrusion Check:

1. Frunk, Gear Tunnel, Cabin: Check for leaks after washing or rain.

Interior Comfort Features:

1. Climate Control: Test A/C, heat, and ventilated seats. Ensure rear-seat climate controls work.

Gear Guard & Cameras:

1. Gear Guard: Ensure Gear Guard records video when motion is detected.
2. Download Footage: Test downloading Gear Guard footage to a USB-C drive.
